



## 7. HEALTH HAZARD DATA

Health Hazards (Acute and Chronic):	May cause mild irritation to eyes, skin, and respiratory tract. Swallowing can cause gastrointestinal irritation, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:			
INHALATION:	Move to fresh air. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.		
EYES:	Flush with water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.		
SKIN:	Wash skin with plenty of water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.		
INGESTION:	If swallowed, drink 2 glasses of water. Induce vomiting only as directed by medical personnel. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.		

## 8. PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

Steps to Be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled:	Absorb spills with inert absorbent material and place in closed chemical waste containers. Dispose of according to federal, state and local regulatory agencies.
Waste Disposal Method:	Consult federal, state and local regulatory agencies to ascertain proper disposal procedures.
Precautions to Be Taken in Handling and Storage:	Store in cool, dry place. Keep containers closed when not in use. Do not store near strong acids or oxidizers. Keep from freezing.
Other Precautions:	KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.

Protective Gloves:	Chemical resistant recommended.
Eye Protection:	Chemical splash goggles.
Other Protective Clothing or Equipment:	Protective clothing where splashing may occur.
Respiratory Protection:	Not normally needed.
Ventilation:	Local Exhaust - Only necessary when general ventilation is not available. Mechanical (General) - Use good general ventilation to prevent over exposure. Special / Other - NA
Work & Hygienic Practices:	Normal.
